



**CPAC GENERAL MEMBERSHIP
MEETING MINUTES
MARCH 9, 2010**

Attendees

Twelve parents plus Mrs. Patricia Sack were in attendance. A sign-in sheet is on file.

Ken Pezanowski called the meeting to order at 6:25 PM.

Welcome and Opening Remarks

Ken welcomed everyone and thanked them for attending the meeting. Introductions were made around the room for our newer members.

Financial Update

As of today, CPAC has \$2,083.50 in the bank account with no outstanding invoices. Mrs. Sack gave us some miscellaneous cash (Dress Down Day, hot chocolate sales, etc.) tonight and we received some envelopes in the mailbox, so we'll add everything up by the next meeting.

Membership Drive

No new membership envelopes have been turned in since the last mailing, so we are still at 8.69% of the student population.

Pasta Night Update

Diane Myers was not at the meeting, so we have decided not to move forward with this event. We will possibly revisit it again during the next school year.

Volunteer Opportunities and Events

Due to the snowstorms and school closings in February, we had to cancel the Hot Chocolate Day and reschedule the Junior Test Information Night (formerly called FAFSA Night) and Spring fund-raiser.

Our Spring fund-raiser is now in full effect and will run from Monday, March 8 through Friday, March 26. Packets were distributed on Monday to all 1st Period classes (Tuesday to the classes that had Career Development on Monday). A flyer was also sent home with the last Interim Report mailing to let the Parents know what we were doing. All money and completed order forms must be dropped off to the Main Office by Friday, March 26. Since Spring Break is the following week, we will not be able to accept any orders after the 26th. A gift card drawing will be held for the top sellers of each class.

Prep will be hosting a Junior Test Information Night on Thursday, March 18 from 6:00 to 8:00 PM. We have gotten permission to sell hot dogs, chips, candy and water/soda that night, so we will need 4-5 parent volunteers to help out. Set-up will start around 5:00 PM. Carm and Ken will purchase the refreshments this weekend. Sign-ups were taken at the meeting.

Prep will also be holding their annual Lottery Night on Thursday, March 25 from 6:00 to 8:00 PM. John B. has given us permission to sell hot dogs, chips, candy and water/soda that

night as well, so we will need 4-5 parent volunteers to help out. Set-up will start around 5:00 PM. Ken will create a flyer to be mailed out, which will let those invited know about the refreshments in the cafeteria. Sign-ups were taken at the meeting.

PSSA testing for the Juniors is scheduled from Wednesday, April 7 through Friday, April 30. Carm has contacted a few caterers but none were able to work with our limited budget. She will talk to Steve at Mastero's on the Avenue to see what our options are and compare them to if we purchase everything ourselves in bulk. Out of the 18 days, we will need at least 2 parent volunteers for 12 of the mornings to help with the set up and clean up. More details to come.

Report Card Night will be held on Thursday, April 22 from 6:00 – 8:00 PM. Approximately 8 volunteers are needed to greet the Parents, hand out report cards and sell refreshments. Sign-ups were taken at the meeting.

The Senior Barbecue is now scheduled for Friday, June 11 at 12:00 noon. Carm will contact Ms. Philyaw and Ms. Junkerman to get students volunteers to help, Jeremy or Montay to see what we can do about tables and Mr. Hunter to help with the food preparation. Montay has already agreed to play music. More details to come at the next meeting.

Ken will update the CPAC website (www.prepcharterparents.com) and send an email to the distribution list asking for volunteers.
